Designer clothing sale this weekend
The National Council of Jewish Women's 47th Designer Dress Days begins Friday. The four-day, high-end fashion resale event at the Mandel Jewish Community Center (26001 S. Woodland Road, Beachwood) is the annual fundraiser to support the NCJW/Cleveland's advocacy initiatives, community service projects and educational programs aimed at bettering the lives of women, children and families. The sale of almost 10,000 articles of new or gently worn women's designer clothing, jewelry, high-end handbags, furs and fashionable accessories is a year in the making. Labels on designer items this year include Louis Vuitton, Chanel, Fendi, Prada, Burberry, Longchamp, Tory Burch, Weiss Furs and Rag & Bone. Last year's event raised \$250,000.
