

National Council of Jewish Women, Cleveland Section, a volunteer charitable organization, wishes to acknowledge with appreciation your gift of merchandise and properties as listed. We would like to call your attention to the Internal Revenue Service Regulation:

- . If your total non-cash charitable contributions for the year are less than \$500, the receipt on the reverse side serves as the acknowledgment of your gift.
- . If your total non-cash charitable contributions to all charities for the year are between \$500 and \$5,000, you must complete IRS Form 8283, Non-Cash Charitable Contributions, Section A, and attach it to your Federal Income Tax Return. For contributions up to \$5,000, you must estimate the value of your gift on Form 8283. NCJW has a list of acceptable values provided by the IRS.
- . If you believe that the fair market value of your non-cash contributions exceeds \$5,000 for the year, you must do two additional things to obtain an income tax deduction:
 - I. You must have a written appraisal performed by a qualified appraiser. That appraiser must sign Section B, Part III of Form 8283. NCJW cannot serve as a qualified appraiser. In connection with the annual Designer Dress Days event, NCJW may assist in finding a qualified appraiser as a service to our donor, if requested.
 - 2. You must also submit your Form 8283 to NCJW so that we can complete Section B, Part IV. NCJW is then required to submit Form 8282, Donee Information Return, to the IRS (with copy to the donor) upon our sale of the contributed item.

We urge you to consult with your tax advisor for more specific information regarding the income tax filing requirements summarized above.

IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO ATTACH THIS RECEIPT TO YOUR INCOME TAX RETURN.
